Family, Career and Community Leaders of America, Inc. (FCCLA) is a nonprofit national career and technical student organization for young men and women in Family and Consumer Sciences Education in public and private schools through grade 12.

BETH MIDDLETON MEMORIAL

This scholarship is awarded to a current or former national or state officer who is a high school senior. The award recognizes outstanding leadership, scholarship, and community service. One application per state may be submitted. The \$400 scholarship is payable in two installments and must be applied to college tuition, room, and/or board.

FCCLA announces their newest scholarship with Enjoy the City Promotions, a division of Kidz-Idz. Enjoy the City Promotions will provide one \$1,000 scholarship annually to a qualified FCCLA member who demonstrates exemplary leadership in FCCLA and in their family, school, and community.

LEADERS AT WORK – FOOD PRODUCTION & SERVICES

Leaders at Work recognizes young people who strengthen leadership skills on the job. The program helps students set goals, make plans, become a leader at work, and prepare for career success. FCCLA members receiving recognition as Outstanding Leaders in Food Production and Services **may** compete for **four** Morris J.W. Gaebe Entrepreneurial \$5,000 tuition scholarships, renewable for four academic years totaling \$20,000 each, to attend Johnson & Wales University and study programs in Business, Hospitality, Culinary Arts and Technology. Two scholarships are offered for Food Production and Services.

LEADERS AT WORK – HOSPITALITY, TOURISM, AND RECREATION

Leaders at Work recognizes young people who strengthen leadership skills on the job. The program helps students set goals, make plans, become a leader at work, and prepare for career success. FCCLA members receiving recognition as Outstanding Leaders in Hospitality, Tourism, and Recreation **may** compete for **four** Morris J.W. Gaebe Entrepreneurial \$5,000 tuition scholarships, renewable for four academic years totaling \$20,000 each, to attend Johnson & Wales University and study programs in Business, Hospitality, Culinary Arts and Technology. Two scholarships are offered for Hospitality, Tourism, and Recreation.

JAPANESE EXCHANGE

Japanese Exchange is a scholarship opportunity for FCCLA members to travel to Japan for four-to-six weeks as an exchange student. This scholarship is funded by the Kikkoman Corporation, administered by Youth For Understanding USA. Scholarships are worth more than \$6,995 each.

NATIONAL TECHNICAL HONOR SOCIETY

This scholarship is awarded annually to two (2) qualified FCCLA members, who are also current members of the National Technical Honor Society. Recipients will be selected based on their contribution and leadership within Family, Career and Community Leaders, as well as the National Technical Honor Society. The \$1,000 scholarship is applied directly to the college or university for tuition, room, or board.

RAYE VIRGINIA ALLEN STATE PRESIDENT'S

This scholarship is awarded annually to a current or former state president who is a high school senior. The award recognizes academic excellence, outstanding leadership, and volunteerism. The \$2,000 scholarship is applied to college tuition to pursue any field of study.
