Applicants will be evaluated based on the application information provided, and the recipients will be selected by a selection committee.

Eligibility:

Open to **nationally** affiliated FCCLA members who:

- are current members of the National Technical Honor Society
- have affiliated nationally with FCCLA by March 1, 2010.

Instructions:

1. Type all information using 10pt. Times New Roman font.
2. Do not alter this form in any way or use abbreviations.
3. Complete all sections of the application.
4. List information chronologically beginning with the earliest date first.
5. Use only the space provided. Do not send additional pages. Applicants will be judged solely on information contained in this form and your recommendations. Applications cannot be returned to applicant.
6. **Attach** your most recent **official high school transcript** including the first semester grades of the current year.
7. Include a copy of your FCCLA chapter affiliation verifying national dues paid by **March 1, 2010**.
8. Applicants must include one (1) recommendation from their local FCCLA adviser. (*Recommendations must be less than 100 words and signed.*)
9. All signatures must be included in this application.
10. Application must be postmarked by **April 1, 2010**.

Applications will be evaluated for style and expression as well as content. Conciseness of written remarks is recommended. This scholarship is a one-time cash award per recipient payable directly to the college or university in the fall of their freshman year. Funds come directly from National Technical Honor Society and must be applied toward tuition, room, and/or board. If recipient withdraws from college, unused funds must be returned. The winners will be notified by **May 2010**. Scholarship winners are invited to attend the 2010 FCCLA National Leadership Conference to receive recognition for their award.
