**Workshop Date and Time**

Workshops will be held on Wednesday, July 8, in the morning and afternoon (8:30 a.m.-12 noon, and 1:00-3:00 p.m.). Workshop will run in multiple rotations. Each workshop will be one hour long. Please indicate on your proposal form which times you are available to present.

**Audio/Visual Requests**

Please indicate on your proposal what AV equipment your workshop will require. Due to a limited AV budget, FCCLA is unable to provide laptops, LCD projectors, and other equipment. We can however provide a screen/set-up for an LCD projector, and arrange for presenters to rent this equipment in addition to wireless microphones, DVD/CD players, audio for presentations, and internet access.

## **Presenter Expectations**

As a presenter, you are expected to meet all deadlines within the proposal process, including the meeting registration and workshop confirmation deadlines. You are responsible for completing the workshop proposal form completely, and willing to submit additional information about your workshop if requested. Presenters will be responsible for all charges related to materials provided to all workshop attendees, including handouts; and provide AV or pay any equipment costs as agreed upon. FCCLA expects all presentations to be professional, age/audience appropriate, and accurately adhere to content submitted in your proposal.

## **Conference Registration**

Please register for the meeting by the May 1 deadline. Nationally affiliated FCCLA chapters receive one complimentary registration if selected to present a workshop. Exhibitors please check exhibit rules for the registration procedure, which can be found on the FCCLA website in the [Meetings section](#). All other presenters are asked to register if they are attending any portion of the meeting. All travel, lodging, and meeting expenses are the responsibility of the presenter. Presenters are eligible for the FCCLA conference rate at the official conference hotels. Housing forms will be available upon confirmation.

## **Selection and Notification**

Workshop proposals will be accepted through **April 9, 2010**. Workshops will be selected based on content, and how well they fit into conference programming. Presentations based solely on a sales pitch will not be considered. Presenters will be notified by **May 1**. Upon notification FCCLA will require a signed confirmation of participation. Please note: FCCLA may modify session title and description to maintain consistency within conference materials.
