Leaders at Work Units

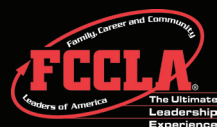
Youth learn leadership skills in specific career units and create Leaders at Work projects to accomplish personal goals in one of six (6) career units related to Family and Consumer Sciences education —
